Access cards are deactivated at 60 days past due. After 60 days past due you will need to rejoin & take the new member orientation again.

Important Club Reminders:

Turn off the lights! While some rooms have been upgraded to motion sensors, most have not. Please save on operation costs and turn off the lights on your way out.

Please clean up after yourself. Leave an area as clean, if not cleaner than you found it. Every member has the authority to take out the trash and replace the bags.

First Aid Kits are located behind the bars of the indoor ranges, and in each of the outdoor ranges.

Holsters are not allowed at SCC.

Eye and Ear Protection Required on all firing lines at all times.

Rifles & Handguns are never to be fired on the Trap and Skeet Fields.

There is NO RAPID FIRE allowed outside of SCC Leagues. RAPID FIRE is part of our zero-tolerance policy and results in an automatic 3-month suspension. There MUST be 2 Seconds Between Each Shot.

Indoor Pistol Range: 8:00 a.m. to 9:30 p.m.

Outdoor Rifle Range: Monday-Friday from 8:00 A.M. to Sunset; Saturday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 P.M. (or sunset if before 5 PM); and Sunday from 8:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M.

Trap Field 4 for hand throw: Monday-Friday from 8:00 A.M. to Sunset; Saturday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 P.M. (or sunset if before 5 PM); and Sunday from 8:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M.
