Eye and Ear Protection Required on all firing lines at all times.

Rifles & Handguns are never to be fired on the Trap and Skeet Fields.

There is NO RAPID FIRE allowed outside of SCC Leagues & Sanctioned Practice. RAPID FIRE is part of our zero-tolerance policy and results in an automatic 3-month suspension. There MUST be 2 Seconds Between Each Shot.
