First Aid Kits are located behind the bars of the
indoor ranges, and in each of the outdoor ranges.

**SNOW REMOVAL: If you arrive to a snow covered
sidewalk and are physically able to clear it, please
do. We are a member run organization and it's
everyone's responsibility to pitch in.**

Turn off the lights! While some rooms have been
upgraded to motion sensors, most have not. Please
save on operation costs and turn off the lights on
your way out.

Please clean up after yourself. Leave an area as
clean, if not cleaner than you found it. Every
member has the authority to take out the trash and
replace the bags.

**Eye and Ear Protection Required
on all firing lines at all times.**

Rifles & Handguns are never to be fired on the
Trap and Skeet Fields.

There is NO RAPID FIRE allowed outside of SCC Leagues
& Sanctioned Practice. RAPID FIRE is part of our zero-
tolerance policy and results in an automatic 3-month
suspension. There MUST be
2 Seconds Between Each Shot.
