Turn off the lights! While some rooms have been upgraded to motion sensors, most have not. Please save on operation costs and turn off the lights on your way out.

First Aid Kits are located behind the bars of the indoor ranges, and in each of the outdoor ranges.

Eye and Ear Protection Required on all firing lines at all times.

Rifles & Handguns are never to be fired on the Trap and Skeet Fields.

There is NO RAPID FIRE allowed outside of SCC Leagues & Sanctioned Practice. RAPID FIRE is part of our zerotolerance policy and results in an automatic 3-month suspension. There MUST be 2 Seconds Between Each Shot.

Indoor & Outdoor Archery Ranges: Open 24/7 Indoor Pistol Range: 8:00 a.m. to 9:30 p.m. Daily

Outdoor Rifle Range: Monday-Friday from 8:00 A.M. to Sunset; Saturday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 P.M. (or sunset if before 5 PM); and Sunday from 8:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M.

Trap Field 4 for hand throw: Monday-Friday from 8:00 A.M. to Sunset; Saturday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 P.M. (or sunset if before 5 PM); and Sunday from 8:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M.
