Important Club Reminders!:

First Aid Kits are located behind the bars of the indoor ranges, and in each of the outdoor ranges

Please clean up after yourself. Leave an area as clean, if not cleaner than you found it. Every member has the authority to take out the trash and replace the bags.

Rifles & Handguns are never to be fired on the Trap and Skeet Fields.

There is NO RAPID FIRE allowed outside of SCC Leagues & Sanctioned Practice. RAPID FIRE is part of our zero-tolerance policy and results in an automatic 6-month suspension. There MUST be 2 Seconds Between Each Shot.

Eye and Ear Protection Required on all firing lines at all times.

Indoor Pistol Range: 8:00 a.m. to 9:30 p.m. Daily

Outdoor Rifle Range: Monday-Friday from 8:00 A.M. to Sunset; Saturday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 P.M. (or sunset if before 5 PM); and Sunday from 8:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M.

Trap Field 4 for hand throw: Monday-Friday from 8:00 A.M. to Sunset; Saturday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 P.M. (or sunset if before 5 PM); and Sunday from 8:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M.
